Following the service, please feel free to join us in the gym for coffee and treats and to get to know one another.



#### A Verse to Think About:

"For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:6

"A child is born" refers to His humanity.

"A son is given" refers to His divinity.
