Monthly Financial Update: November 2024

November	35,150.36	22,546.58	12,603.78
YTD Totals	264,281.18	267,119.90	-2,838.72

We had very good income in November. However, we still
have a negative balance of \$2,838.72 and are still \$14,562
short of our full 2024 budget goal.

Christmas Special Offering: The Elders have decided that the
Christmas Special offering should go toward the General Fund
of FBC, as was the Thanksgiving offering we feel our priority is
to make up the deficit in the budget.
